NYU Langone Hospital – Long Island Senior Leader Named Board Chair, Nassau-Suffolk Hospital Council

September 14, 2026 (Hauppauge, NY) – *Garden City, NY resident and Executive Vice President and Chief of Hospital Operations for [NYU Langone Hospital - Long Island](#), Joseph Greco MD*, was appointed to a two-year term as board chair of the [Nassau-Suffolk Hospital Council](#) (NSHC) at the association's annual meeting held July 16, 2026.

Dr. Greco assumed the hospital's leadership in 2019, after having served the institution as Chief Medical Officer and prior to that appointment as chair of Anesthesiology for more than a decade. He brings to bear nearly 30 years of clinical experience to hospital leadership and has guided the hospital in offering an advanced heart failure program and access to a transplant program with the fastest transplant rates in the state. Under his leadership, the hospital also achieved designation as a Comprehensive Stroke Center.
