Statement on 2026 – 2027 Proposed State Budget

We appreciate that Governor Hochul's proposed 2026 - 2027 state budget is focused on ensuring stability for hospitals and other healthcare institutions amidst steep federal funding reductions, disruptions in insurance coverage and a rapidly changing federal regulatory environment. Her budget acknowledges both the extensive health cuts our state faces and the increases in uncompensated care hospitals will absorb due to the increased number of uninsured as a result of the 2025 federal tax bill. We are grateful that her budget calls for maintaining the Medicaid rate increases to providers legislated last year and seeks to provide \$1.5 billion in new funding to bolster the hospital and nursing home sectors, as well as additional funding for the Safety Net Transformation program.

It's a long way to April 1, 2026, when the new state fiscal year begins. Our hospitals are committed to working with the legislature and executive branch to bring balance and stability to New York's healthcare system.
